## HEALTHY BYTES

### More on Cayenne Pepper...

Cayenne pepper moves blood. Wherever you apply cayenne pepper, blood will come to that area. It is impossible to abuse cayenne pepper. It will never cause a blister. It is from the capsicum family and not the chili family. Black pepper and chili are both irritants to the gastrointestinal tract. Cayenne pepper is not. Cayenne pepper can be used internally and externally. The easiest way to use cayenne pepper is to put about a 1/4 teaspoon in a cup of water and throw it down. Excellent for a sore throat. It will REALLY tingle, but when the tingle dies down you will find that you will hardly have a sore throat. Follow with a glass of cold water. If you have digestive problems, it will wake up the digestive enzymes and bring them to that area.

Cayenne pepper will cause a constriction of bleeding vessels. Cayenne pepper can heal a stomach ulcer. For external bleeding, like with a cut, sprinkle cayenne pepper in it and it will stop the bleeding (yes it will sting a bit, but it is already hurting from the cut).
