ANNUAL HARVEST CARNIVAL

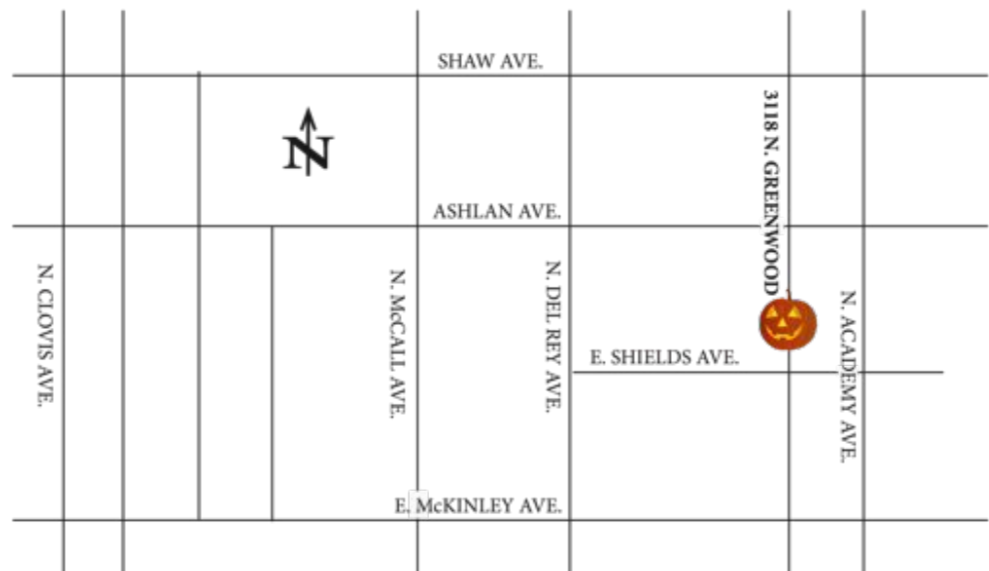
This Saturday evening will be lots of fun at our Annual Harvest Carnival. See the announcement on page 3 for more details.

HEALTHY BYTES
Fall Soups Edition

Quinoa Zucchini Soup

Ingredients:

- Olive Oil to coat the pan for sauteing
- 1 onion
- 2 carrots
- 2-3 stalks of celery, chopped
- 1-2 zucchini, chopped
- 1 quart of tomatoes
- 2 cups of water (or vegetable stock)
- 2-3 cups chicken broth or vegetable stock
- 1/2 cup of quinoa
- 1-2 potatoes, chopped or cubed
- Salt and Pepper to taste
- 1 Tablespoon Italian Seasoning

Saute onion, carrots and celery until crisp. Add zucchini and potato and cook for another 2-3 minutes before adding the tomatoes. Slowly add water and chicken broth (or vegetable broth). Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to simmer and add the quinoa and spices and let simmer for 30 minutes or so. Add more or less vegetables according to your preference.
