STEVEN MOSLEY'S DRAMATIC MINISTRY

This Sabbath, during the worship hour, Steven Mosley will present "Likely Suspects" – a dramatic presentation that takes people through the Bible story – looking back from the "scene of the crime," the cross of Christ.

"It's a mystery story focusing on why Jesus had to die. A hardboiled detective, Sammy Slade, imagines he can solve this 'cold case' once and for all. Likely Suspects gives the audience a new appreciation of our need for the gracious forgiveness that comes from the One rejected and despised by humanity."

Omega-3 and Omega-6 Oils

It's easy to get mixed up between omega-3 and omega-6; basically, omega-3 acids are the fats which are not so easy to come by. They're in fish oils, flax seeds, kiwi seeds, and chia seeds, amongst other things. Omega-6, on the other hand, is found almost everywhere you look: nuts, vegetable oils, avocadoes, etc. As important as omega-6 oils are to our health,

the balance of omega-3 to omega-6 is equally important. As it is so easy to consume plenty of omega-6, it is very easy to end up with an unbalanced

consumption of the two types of oils, which are also known as essential oils. When it comes to the amount of omega-3 oil in various seed oils, the chia seed has the highest content, just above kiwi seeds, perilla and flax. Sprinkle whole chia seeds on your salad. There is no flavor, just a crunch. If you use flaxseed, be sure to grind it first as the whole seed won't break down in the body like the chia seed will. The fish do not produce omega-3 oil, they eat the sea vegetables that have it in it.
