Tomato Soup (shared by Angela Reijnders)

Ic raw cashews

2c water*

IT onion powder

It sea salt

3T olive oil**

It ground oregano

I-2T dried sweet basil

2T honey



Mix ingredients in blender until completely smooth. Then add:

I qt. stewed tomatoes

and blend again until completely smooth and creamy. Adjust salt and other spice measurements to your taste buds. Heat all or as much as you will eat and refrigerate the rest for later.

*It is ok to add more water, up to three cups, for desired thickness.
