HEALTH BYTES



QUINOA (pronounced Keen-wah) This seed has a flavor that grows on you. You have to take more than one bite! By the end of the bowl you are going to want more. The quinoa seed is high in protein, calcium and iron, a relatively good source of vitamin E and several of the B vitamins. It contains an almost perfect balance of all eight essential amino acids needed for tissue development in humans. The protein in quinoa is considered to be a complete protein due to the presence of all 8 essential amino acids. Try substituting quinoa for rice or barley in casseroles and

soups. You can purchase quinoa at health food stores and Costco now has Organic Quinoa in their grain section.

A break from oatmeal:

2 cups orange juice
1 t. maple syrup or raw honey
1/8 t. sea salt
1 1/3 c. quinoa, well washed
2 T. pecans, roasted and chopped very fine

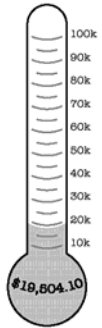
Combine the juice, honey and salt in a medium saucepan over high heat and bring to a boil. Watch closely to keep the juice from boiling over. Add the quinoa, cover, lower heat, and simmer for 12 to 15 minutes, or until all the juice has been absorbed. Remove from heat and let rest for 5 minutes. Add the pecans and fluff with a fork. Makes 3 ¾ cups.
