Have you given up Jello because of the animal by-products or the MSG in the prepackaged brands? Well, deprived yourself no more! Here is a healthy version of jello and you won’t be able to tell the difference, except for that headache you won’t get from the MSG in the prepackaged brand. Enjoy!

JELLO



- 4 Cups Blueberry or other 100% berry juice
- 4 Tbls. Emes kosher gelatin
- 1 Twelve ounce can frozen 100% juice concentrate (do not dilute; grape or raspberry taste good)
- 4-5 cups frozen berries

Heat berry juice with gelatin stirred in until it has reached the simmering point. Simmer and stir 1-2 min. until gelatin dissolved. Remove from heat, and add the frozen juice concentrate. Add in your frozen fruit in any combination. Gently pour over cream cheese filling. Refrigerate until set.

(Once I didn’t have any berry juice so I just pureed some frozen berries and added a little water and they tasted great. It was probably a bit more tart, but very good.)
