PASTOR'S NOTES

GIVING IN 2009

In 2008, the total giving to Sunnyside (tithe, church budget, building fund, youth pastor, etc.) was \$627, 751. I was blown away to learn this week that the total giving in 2009 was \$1,051, 212. That is an increase of 67%! In the midst of a bad economy, no less. Tithe increased by 5%, from \$269,815 in '08 to \$283,032 in '09. Church budget contributions increased by 6%, from \$217,161 to \$230,474. And, contributions to the building went from \$45,782 in 2008 to \$453,651 in 2009, an increase of 891%. Wow!

I thank God and the Sunnyside congregation for being wonderfully generous.

CREDIT CARDS

Effective January 1, the conference is now charging us 6% on donations made via credit card. That means that any donation made to the church using a credit card will be reduced by 6%. That is an expensive processing fee, so we are currently looking into doing the processing ourselves so that the fee will be around 2%. In the meantime, if you want to make credit card donations without the 6% fee, we encourage you to donate through the church website, http://sunnyside.adventistfaith.org/. The processing fee there is 1.5%.

SERMON SERIES

The Sabbath, I am kicking off a new sermon series on the life of Jacob. While Jacob was a patriarch, he certainly wasn't a saint. He lived an interesting life with lots of highs and lows. Our architect and engineers have agreed to have their design revisions done on Friday, January 8 for resubmission to the city. According to Garry Clark, it is reasonable to hope for completion of the city review and a permit by the end of January.
