AT LEAST 522 ADVENTISTS KNOWN DEAD IN HAITI EARTHQUAKE

In the aftermath of the Jan. 12 earthquake that struck ten miles west of the Haitian capital, members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church are tallying the grim human toll. Top Seventh-day Adventist leaders in Haiti reported that, so far as it is known, the 7.0-magnitude earthquake killed 522 church members, the vast majority young people. More than 55 churches were destroyed, 60 churches partially damaged and some 27,000 church members left homeless in the capital city of Port-au-Prince. The official report came as local leaders met with top church leaders of the Inter-American Division on January 20. It took leaders one week to account for their ministers, church employees, members, and churches in the wake of the tremblor's aftermath, which left leaders virtually without communication for a few days.
