PASTOR'S NOTES

CHURCH OFFICE IS MOVING

Yesterday, the city inspectors gave us permission to occupy the office space in our new church. We are moving the church office into the new facility this coming Sunday (yes, we're moving on Father's Day). If you would like to help with the move, please meet at the old church office at 9 AM. Our first day of business in the new space will be next Monday. REMODEL UPDATE

Every time I stop by the new church there is noticeable progress. In addition to the completion of the office space, the entire interior is almost completely sheet rocked. The baptistery is in place and the foyer is starting to feel like a foyer. This week, several of our church members are working side-by-side with the construction crews. Bruce Eckhart, Wil Reimer, and Bruce's father are laying tile in the bathrooms. Ron Estep, Todd Bristol, and Dave Smith are priming and painting the exterior. At this point, we are on schedule to begin worshipping in our church in August.

FUNDRAISER

To help pay for all the work being done on our church, there will be a fundraiser in the Hope Community Center on Sunday, from 5 to 8 pm. It will include a concert by Sunnyside Grace, refreshments, and an auction.

YOUTH PASTOR FUND

One of the consequences of raising funds for our new church is that giving to other ministries at Sunnyside has inevitably decreased. The one that particularly concerns me is the Youth Pastor Fund. It is currently at \$18,790, which is the lowest it has ever been. I'm told by our church treasurer that approximately 70% of our congregation is contributing to the building fund, which is very much appreciated. Among the remaining approximately 30%, I realize that there are some who have not contributed because they were not in favor of the decision to buy a new church or to remodel it. If you are one of those, would you consider making a donation to the Youth Pastor Fund? Ministry to our young people has always been one of Sunnyside's top values, even more important than owning our own facility. If you are one who has not given to the church building for personal reasons, please consider supporting the youth ministry so that we can keep it going strong during this time that we focus our fundraising on the new church. I would hate to see us come to a point where we can no longer pay a Youth Pastor to minister to our young people.


