HEALTHY BYTES

Feed your eyes. The four groups of nutrients that feed the retina are carotenoids (lutein and zeaxanthin), flavonoids, vitamins, and omega-3s. The best sources of lutein and zeaxanthin are kale, spinach, Swiss chard, green peas, corn and summer squash. You need 6 to 10 mg. daily. You get the equivalent of this by eating a cup of greens three times a week.

"SEE" Foods: salmon, blueberries, spinach, kale, Swiss chard, collard greens, green peas, bell peppers, pumpkin, zucchini, red grapes, nuts, yellow corn, broccoli, carrots, egg yolk.
