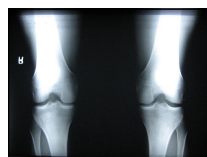

## HEALTHY BYTES

**Bone Health:** Phosphorus combines with calcium like cement mix to give strength to the bone. Calcium and phosphorus partner with each other to build stronger bones, yet theirs is a delicate balance. Too much phosphorus can actually weaken the bone. Ideally, a diet should contain calcium and phosphorus in equal amounts. The standard American diet contains more than twice as much phosphorus as calcium. Meat protein, processed foods, and carbonated soft drinks (high in phosphoric acid, the fizzy stuff) are high in phosphorus. Sodas are really bad for bone health. A twelve-ounce can of cola can rob the body of 100 mg. of calcium.



Research shows that vegetarians of all ages tend to have greater bone density than meat eaters.

Studies show that a healthy low-impact activity such as walking not only helps repair worn-out cartilage in the knee joint but also builds new cartilage.

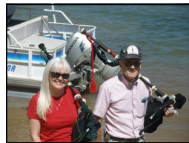

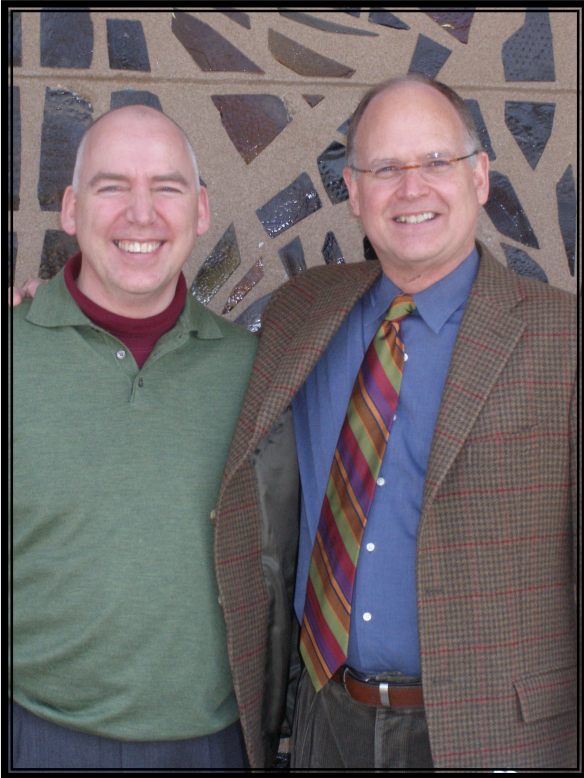
### Yosemite Ridge Needs Volunteer Specialists

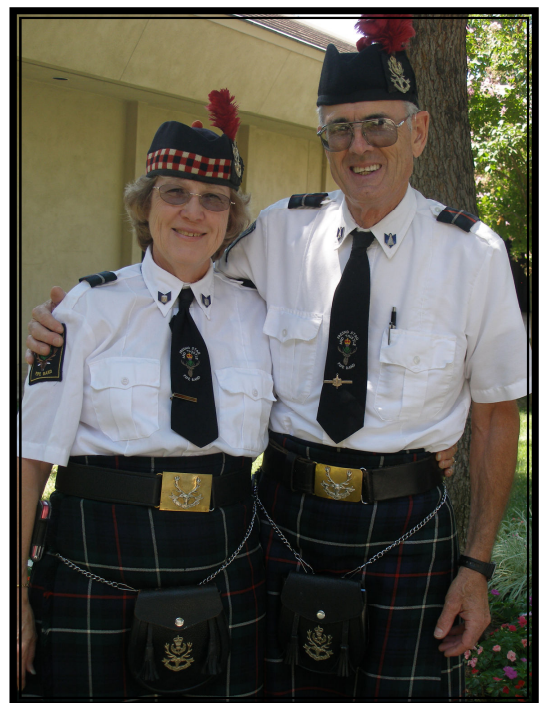
