Adults will have a class inside the chapel. The church service will be 11:00-12:00 in the Chapel with Pastor Dennis Ray speaking.

At the Camp Edison Towhee picnic site: Early Youth and Youth will meet 10:30-12:00 for a Sabbath school/worship service with Pastor Cal.

Immediately after Church (approximately 1:00 PM) all will meet at the lake for an afternoon of fun at the Camp Edison Towhee site.
