HEALTHY BYTES



Basil is low in Saturated Fat, and very low in Cholesterol and Sodium. It is also a good source of Protein, Vitamin E (Alpha Tocopherol), Riboflavin and Niacin, and a very good source of Dietary Fiber, Vitamin A, Vitamin C, Vitamin K, Vitamin B6,

Folate, Calcium, Iron, Magnesium, Phosphorus, Potassium, Zinc, Copper and Manganese. Here is a recipe that we enjoy with pasta or as a spread on a cracker or with veggies. Stays well in the refrigerator for 2 weeks.

PESTO

All these amounts are suggestions. You can adjust to your own taste.

I packed cup fresh basil leaves, without stems

3 garlic cloves

I cup pine nuts, toasted

¼ t. salt

1/2 c. extra virgin olive oil 1/3 c. grated Romano cheese

In food processor, pulse all ingredients except oil until fine. Drizzle oil in and pulsate for a few seconds until paste. Serve over hot pasta.

CHURCH AT SHAVER LAKE - AUGUST 21, 2010

Sabbath August 21, Fresno Sunnyside Church will meet at Shaver Lake rather than in Fresno.



Shaver Lake Community Chapel: Sabbath School classes 10:00-10:50. Cradle Roll, Kindergarten, Primary and Junior divisions will meet at the Picnic Tables behind the church.

Cradle Roll will do a nature walk, craft, & snack. Kindergarten will do a nature hike, lesson, craft & snack. Primary will do a nature walk and craft. Juniors will do a nature walk and discussion. Adults will have a class inside the chapel. The church service will be 11:00-12:00 in the Chapel with Pastor Dennis Ray speaking.

At the Camp Edison Towhee picnic site: Early Youth and Youth will meet 10:30-12:00 for a Sabbath school/worship service with Pastor Cal.

Immediately after Church (approximately I:00 PM) all will meet at the lake for an afternoon of fun at the Camp Edison Towhee site. For lunch, beef hot dogs (generously donated by Bar-S Meats), vegetarian Big Franks, buns, condiments, ice water and table service will be provided. Members are asked to bring cold salad or a dessert, chips and drinks (enough for your family and extra for guests) in an ice chest. After lunch, pontoon-boat rides on the lake will be available as will fellowship on land.

Things are casual this day, so dress comfortably for church and afternoon. Items to bring include folding chairs and /or blankets to sit on, sunscreen, insect repellant, and a sweater or light jacket for evening. Temperatures are about 20° cooler than the valley. You will need money for entrance to picnic area (\$5/car & \$2/person).

Due to concerns about liability and the fact that there will be no lifeguard on duty swimming is strongly discouraged. Many in our church family like to stretch the day into a weekend in the mountains.Information on campsites can be found at www.campedison.com

Remember this is a great opportunity to acquaint others with the Love of God and for each other that we share at Sunnyside Church, so invite family and friends!

<u>Directions to Shaver Lake Community Center Chapel</u>: Take Highway 168 East from Fresno to Shaver Lake. As you come into town you will notice the Sawmill Restaurant on your right. As you pass the restaurant immediately look LEFT and you will see a quaint White Church. Turn Left and park between the church and the community center. If you pass Dinkey Creek Road in your attempt to find the church, TURN AROUND and look for the only white church in town. Travel time from Fresno I-1¹/₄ hours.

<u>Directions to Shaver Lake Picnic Site at Camp Edison "Towhee"</u>: Take Highway 168 1.6 miles past the Community Center Chapel, turn right at the Camp Edison (PG&E) Campground turnout. Proceed to the Toll booth. Entrance fee is \$5 per vehicle and \$2 for each person in vehicle. Proceed on road following signs to Picnic area. Sunnyside Church signs will also be posted. Take right turnout at Towhee Campsite. Those who are able-bodied should park on the asphalt above the picnic area. Those who have a little harder time walking on uneven ground can drive down to the picnic site.


