HEALTHY BYTES

ZUCCHINI BREAD



Beat well together:

3 cage free eggs
2 cups raw sugar
1 cup olive oil

Sift together:

3 cups whole wheat pastry flour
1 t. baking powder
1 t. sea salt
1 t. baking soda
2 t. cinnamon
(May use 1 t. each cinnamon, ginger and cloves)

Combine all above & add: 2 cups grated zucchini squash and 3 t. vanilla.

Mix lightly, but well (I put all in large mixer). You may add raisins, coconut, chopped nuts. Bake at 350° for 1 hour or until tests done with tooth pick.

Nineteen years ago, I was a new mother. I'd always wanted to have a child, but, like most new parents, I was somewhat surprised at how overwhelming it was to keep my baby happy twenty-four hours a day.

One particular evening, my little son had been overly fussy, and both of us were worn out from his crying. Finally, exhausted, I lay down on the couch with the baby stretched across my chest. Both baby and I fell fast asleep.
