HEALTHY BYTES

SUNRISE CRUNCHY GRANOLA

5 cups rolled oats
2 cups wheat flakes (or 2 more cups
rolled oats for GF)
1 cup oat bran
1 cup raw sunflower seeds
½ cup raw sesame seeds
1 cup whole or sliced almonds

2 cups finely shredded unsweetened coconut
1 cup water
½ cup raw cashews, well rinsed
2 cups pitted dates
1 can (12 oz.) frozen unsweetened pineapple juice con-
centrate, thawed
1 teaspoon almond extract
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
1 teaspoon ground coriander
½ teaspoon sea salt
2 cups raisins (optional only after baking)

Preheat oven to 170° F. Place first seven ingredients in very large bowl and mix thoroughly. Make the fruit cream: Place remaining ingredients, except for raisins, in blender and blend for several minutes until creamy. Mix blended fruit cream with dry ingredients until they are lightly and evenly moistened. (It is best to use your hands for this!) Spread mixture in three large baking dishes about 1 inch deep. Place the pans in the oven before bedtime. The granola will be ready at sunrise and the house will smell delicious! Toss raisins together with granola after removing from oven. Makes 40 servings. Store in airtight container. Note: The “fruit cream” also makes a great syrup for pancakes or waffles. This granola is also for last week’s Blueberry Crisp Recipe.

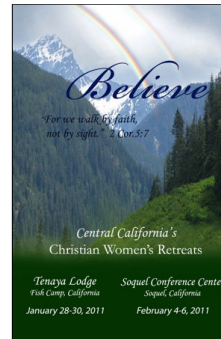
