## PASTOR'S NOTES

### HARVEST FESTIVAL CANCELLED

Due to the forecast of rain for this weekend, the Social Committee has made the difficult decision to cancel the Harvest Festival that was scheduled for Saturday night. Because the Harvest Festival requires many hours of planning and set-up, the Social Committee does not have the luxury of waiting until the last minute to decide whether to cancel it. Since the best information available at this time says that it will likely rain sometime between Friday and Saturday evening, it is cancelled. The Harvest Festival will likely be held in early October next year in hopes of getting better weather.

**GRAINS...**Switching from white bread to whole wheat -- as well as from white rice and pasta to brown rice and whole-wheat or brown rice pasta -- saves calories while providing you with fiber and essential nutrients. Remember, the more fiber a food has, the fewer carbohydrates your body absorbs! Eating simple carbs (those that lack fiber), quickly raises your serum glucose levels and leads to a quick crash soon after. For example, when choosing cereals, keep in mind that the goal is to choose high-fiber cereals and steer clear of those heavy in added sugar and high-fructose corn syrup.

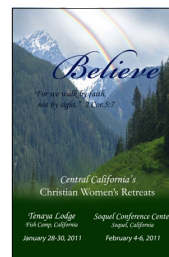
### DID YOU MISS YOUR CHANCE?
