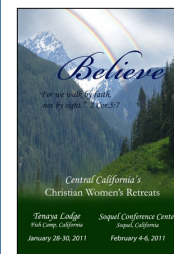
The Fresno Adventist Academy Christmas Program has been changed to **Tuesday, December 7 at 6:30 p.m.**

REMEMBERED...

Veteran's Day is officially November 11, the day that marked the end of World War I. The cessation of fighting between Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month, November 11, 1918.

President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the first Armistice Day in 1919 with the following words: "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the Country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations" Since then the holiday has been expanded to Veterans Day to honor all men and women who are veterans of the United States military services.
