Condiments added without considering their nutrition profile can wreak havoc on your diet. Salad dressings usually contain more calories than the other contents of an entire salad combined. A typical serving of salad dressing contains anywhere from 100 to 200 calories. Swap out your typical high-fat, high-caloric choices like mayonnaise, teriyaki sauce and duck sauce with fat-free alternatives like mustard, balsamic and red wine vinegar. FYI: Most Oriental Chicken

Salad dressing in restaurants like Applebee's is made with chicken fat – not a healthy, low calorie choice.

From the Adventurer Family Network...


