HEALTHY BYTES

CASHEW CHEESE

BLEND until VERY smooth the following:
1 c. Raw cashew pieces (1 gram fiber/oz.)
1/3 c. lemon juice
1 c. water
1/2 c. olive oil

When mixture is smooth to touch, ADD:
2 T. sesame seeds (hulled) (1 gram fiber/T.)
4 T. Nutritional Yeast flakes (4 grams/
heaping T.)
1 t. onion powder
pinch garlic powder
1/8 t. celery seed or celery salt
1 to 1 1/2 t. sea salt



When blended, ADD 1/2 c. sweet pimentos or roasted red peppers and blend again. (This is for color only, doesn’t seem to change the taste).

Use in Lasagna or “mac and cheese” with brown rice noodles for a healthy alternative. Tinkyada brand pasta is best. NOTE: For nachos: add jalapeno pepper and/or 1 can Ortega chilies. Makes a great enchiladas ‘cheese’. There are approx. 26 grams of fiber in this whole recipe. I don’t recommend eating the whole batch in one sitting!

Illuminated glass panels on North and East walls

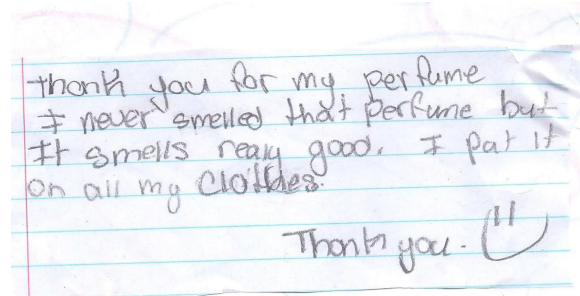
Benches and Trash Containers \$3,000

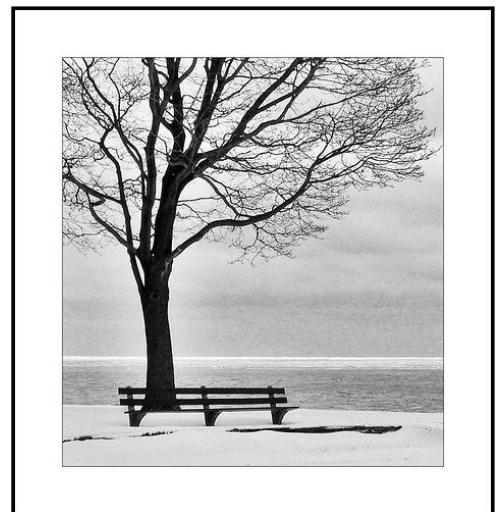
