PASSING OF GARY BOHLMAN

Gary Richard Bohlman M.D. was born on May 9th, 1946 in Walla Walla, Washington to parents Ivan and Lola Bohlman and passed away on January 17th, 2011 due to complications from poor health and a series of strokes. He, along with his then wife and children, was one of the founding 8 families that started the Sunnyside SDA Church Company on Belmont Ave. in 1987. He is survived by four children, Shelly L. Hansen, Michael S. Bohlman, M.D., Jeffery M. Bohlman, and Juli E. Bohlman, 5 grandchildren and ex-wife Barbara L Bohlman. He is also survived by an older sister and two older brothers. His body will be cremated and grave side services will be held at Mount Hope Cemetery in College Place, Washington in the spring – Sunday, April 24, 2011.

HEALTHY BYTES



WATER! IT’S A MIRACLE!

If you don’t take in an adequate amount of water, you will likely find it impossible to achieve control over your weight! What this means is 10-12 eight ounce glasses of WATER per day, plus eight more ounces for every 25 pounds you are overweight. This is the basic requirement for healthy living. Unfortunately, not many people drink as much water as they need. Many problems of weight control can be cured by increasing your water intake. Constipation, nausea, and headaches can all be helped with this, the greatest nutritional supplement in the world. WATER!

Wine, gin, coffee, tea, fruit juices, and soft drinks are all fluids, but they don’t have the same chemical properties as ordinary water. Alcohol and soda pop contains too much sugar, so to a lesser extent do fruit juices. The caffeine in coffee and tea is bad for your heart and blood pressure. Even diet soda contains sodium which contributes to water retention. Cut down on coffee, drink less soda if you like them, but most importantly, drink 10-12 eight ounce glasses of water daily.

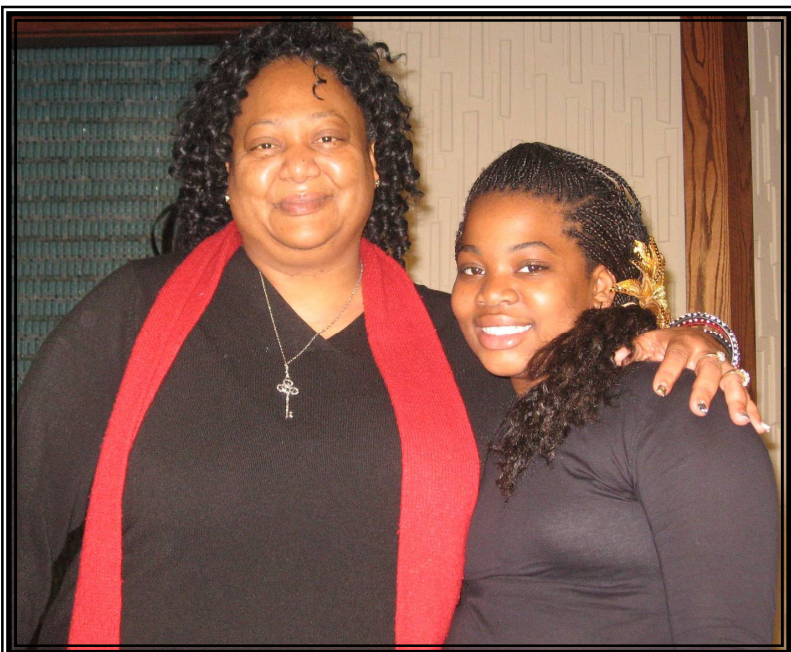
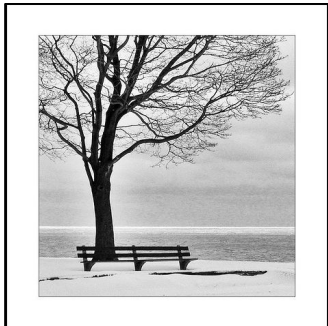


CCC WOMEN'S RETREATS
