



HEALTHY BYTES

Not Losing Weight? Try Increasing the Super Foods in Your Diet: Fruit — Part 2

Out of all the weight loss super foods (those foods that battle unwanted pounds for you), fruit is the easiest to add to any diet. Fruit is tasty, colorful, and most of all, portable. It doesn't matter if it's frozen or fresh – you get the same nutritional load either way. However, dry fruit tends to have a higher glycemic (sweetness) load and canned fruit tends to have lots of added sugar. Adding fruit to your meals — because fruit is so versatile, it's easy to add it to a variety of meals.

Berries (blackberries, raspberries, blueberries, strawberries) — With the exception of a few months in the spring, berries tend to be quite expensive, but frozen berries are just as nutritious. Add them to your bowl of cereal/oatmeal in the morning. Sprinkle on some walnuts and you have an invigorating start to your day.



Apples/Pears — Apples and pears are some of the most portable and readily available fruit. Eating just one with a meal will boost your fiber intake by at least 3.5 grams. So pack some in your on-the-go meal.

Citrus Fruit (oranges, mandarins, grapefruit) – Replace your daily orange juice with the real fruit and you'll increase your fiber intake by 3g. Citrus fruit also add zing to any boring salad.


At the Camp Edison Towhee picnic site: Early Youth and Youth will meet 10:30-12:00 for a Sabbath school/worship service with Pastor Cal.

Immediately after Church (approximately 1:00 PM) all will meet at the lake for an afternoon of fun at the Camp Edison Towhee site. MAP & DIRECTIONS TO SHAVER LAKE EVENTS August 20, 2011




Directions to Shaver Lake Community Center Chapel: Take Highway 168 East from Fresno to Shaver Lake. As you come into town you will notice the Sawmill Restaurant on your right. As you pass the restaurant immediately look LEFT and you will see a quaint White Church. Turn Left and park between the church and the community center. If you pass Dinkey Creek Road in your attempt to find the church, TURN AROUND and look for the only white church in town. Travel time from Fresno 1-11/4 hours.

<u>at Camp Edison "Towhee"</u>: Take Highway 168 I.6 miles past the Community Center Chapel, turn right at the Camp Edison (PG&E) Campground turnout. Proceed to the Toll booth. Entrance fee is \$10 per vehicle. Proceed on road following signs to Picnic area. Sunnyside Church signs will also be posted. Take right turnout at Towhee Campsite. Those who are ablebodied should park on the asphalt above the picnic area. Those who have a little harder time walking on uneven ground can drive down to the picnic site.
