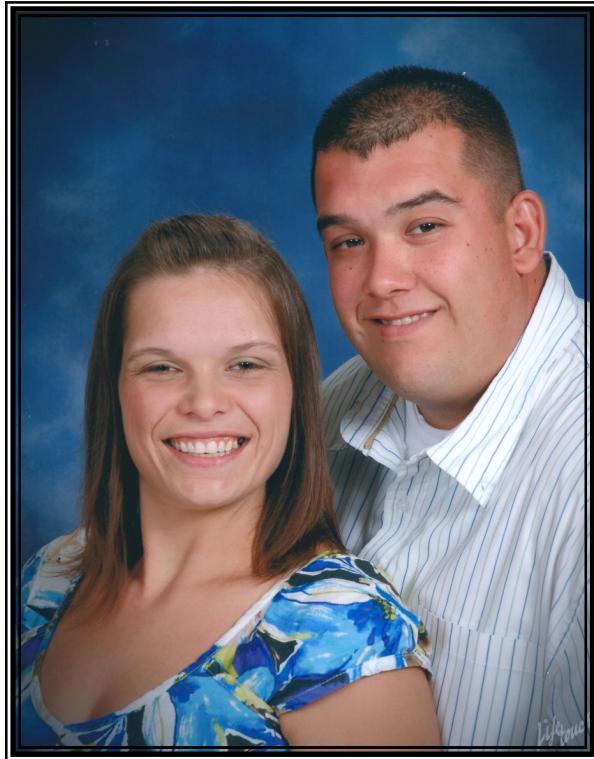


WOMEN'S FRIENDSHIP CIRCLE
