Want to Try Quinoa But Don't Know Where to Begin?

Quinoa & Black Beans

I T – Olive oil

I – Onion, chopped

3 – Garlic cloves, minced

³/₄ cup – Quinoa, uncooked

I $\frac{1}{2}$ cups – Vegetable broth

I t - Ground cumin

¼ t − Cayenne pepper

1/2 cup - Cilantro, fresh & chopped

I cup – Corn kernels, fresh or frozen (You can also just use a can of corn after drained)

2-15oz cans – Black beans, rinsed & drained

Sauté onion and garlic in the olive oil until onions are translucent and tender. Add quinoa, vegetable broth, cumin, and cayenne pepper to sautéed mixture. Bring mixture to a boil, cover, reduce heat, and simmer for 30 minutes. Stir in corn, beans, and cilantro. Cook for an additional 5 minutes on low to

marry the flavors. Of course, salt and pepper to taste. You can serve the Quinoa & Black Beans as a main dish with some corn chips and salsa. It would work great as a side dish too.
