A LETTER FROM PASTOR CAL

Dear Church Family,

It is with sadness that I am tendering my resignation as Youth Pastor effective January 1, 2012.

This may come as a shock to many of you and you may be wondering what has brought about this decision. To answer that question and to put to rest any rumors, the reason I am resigning is that I believe that God is calling me to a time away from all ministry activities and to a time of personal growth and healing.

Both Jessica and I love you, our church family, and still want to be a part of the Sunnyside Seventh-day Adventist Church. We do not feel that God is calling us to go somewhere else, we simply believe that God is calling me to take a break from ministerial activities for an unknown period of time.

In order to help make this transition period a little smoother, beginning in January of 2012, I intend to take at least a one month hiatus from worshipping at Sunnyside. I also intend to take at least a 6 month break from being involved in any form of ministry to allow for a time of personal healing, recalibration and regeneration.

I would like to take this opportunity to say a huge thank you to the parents and financial supporters of the Youth Ministry. Thank you so much for your time and dedication to ministering to our kids. It makes a big difference knowing that their church family care so much.

I would also like to say a special thank you to my kids; the youth. Thank you for letting me into a little piece of your world. Thank you for letting me experience a small piece of life with you. You guys are great and loved so very much. I'm sorry if I haven't been there when you've needed me, or if we haven't connected like we should have. I want you guys to know that I'm proud of you, I love you and you'll always have a special place in my heart.

I would like to thank you, my church family, so much for the amazing opportunity and privilege I have had to serve such a wonderful group of people. Sunnyside is the type of church Jessica and I have always dreamed about serving and worshipping in. The openness to ideas and acceptance of people here is a rarity and are some of the things we treasure deeply about the heart and soul of this church. We hope that we have been half as much of a blessing to you as you have been to us.

Both Jessica and I are very much at peace with this decision.

I do not know what God has in store for us in the future, but Jess and I would like to take this opportunity to say we love you all and thank you for your continued support and prayer throughout our journey and during this transition period.




